Letter from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,

As we reflect on the past year at Project New Hope Inc. (PNH), we are filled with gratitude for the unwavering support of our community, partners, and donors who make our mission possible. What began 14 years ago as a vision to support Veterans beyond their military service has grown into a life-changing network of retreats, programs, and services for Veterans, Service Members, and their Families.

In 2024, we expanded our impact thanks to your trust and generosity. From trauma-informed wellness retreats to emergency financial assistance, SNAP enrollment, and peer support for caregivers and Gold Star Families—our services continue to grow in both reach and depth. We proudly operate Sully's Veterans Food & Baby Pantries, which have become a lifeline for Veterans facing food insecurity.

Thanks to your contributions, 93% of every dollar went directly to program services. This year, our total support reached \$971,793, with \$766,616 invested into life-enhancing programs. These numbers reflect not only responsible stewardship but also a shared commitment to our Veterans' healing, stability, and hope.
